Privacy Policy

- 1) Joining Swaledale and Arkengarthdale Archaeology Group
 - a. We ask members to disclose their:
 - i. Name (Required)
 - ii. Address
 - iii. Telephone number
 - iv. Email address (Required)
 - b. The details disclosed in a. above are generally available to other SWAAG members, so that members can contact one another when arranging activities.
 - c. We ask all SWAAG members not to disclose any of this information outside the group without prior permission from the member concerned.
- 2) Members' Only Web Pages
 - a. All SWAAG members will have access to the majority of these pages.
 - b. There are restrictions on some 'editorial control pages'.
 - c. Members will be issued with a SWAAG username and initial password to access these pages. Each member can then change their password as required.
 - d. Members passwords are saved on the SWAAG database in encrypted form.
 - e. Forgotten passwords are not recoverable, but you can use the access link to enter your username; for the system to automatically generate a new password, which you can then change to one of your choice.
 - f. Forgotten usernames can be recovered by emailing Stephen Eastmead.
- 3) Cookies - The 2011 EU regulations require:
 - a. SWAAG to enable users to opt out of having any permanent cookie set on their computer.
 - b. But allows any temporary cookie to be set which enables any required service to be provided. Temporary cookies delete shortly after closing the browser.
 - c. These regulations will not be enforced until May 2012, which enables browser and other functions to be developed to better accommodate these rules.
 - d. SWAAG currently uses 4 cookies:
 - i. Permanent - Google Analytics for website traffic analysis
 - ii. Permanent - Statcounter.com for website traffic analysis
 - iii. Temporary - SWAAG Database username/password cookie
 - iv. Temporary – SWAAG Database passing search criteria between webpages.
